Bachelor's degree with a major in Information Systems, Computer Science, or Business preferred.

Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions and deal effectively with members, employees and associates. Must be flexible, organized and able to plan work which requires evaluating facts to determine courses of action. Good communication and interpersonal skills are essential.
