

Discuss the challenges in identifying substance use disorders (SUD); identify warning signs in patients with or at risk for addiction/SUD.

*** "Shades of Grey: How to Identify Patients at Risk for Substance Use Disorders" is eligible to count towards (1) the eight hours of training on treatment and management of patients with opioid or other substance use disorders required for all U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration-registered practitioners, and (2) the two hours of CME in the study of pain management and the prescribing and monitoring of controlled substances required by the Texas Medical Board (TMB).

This talk will address the TMB-specified topics of:

- Best practices, alternative treatment options, and multi-modal approaches to pain management that may include physical therapy, psychotherapy, and other treatments:
- Safe and effective pain management related to the prescription of opioids and other controlled substances, including education regarding:
 - Standards of care;
 - Identification of drug-seeking behavior in patients;
 - Effectively communicating with patients regarding the prescription of an opioid or other controlled substances; and
 - » Prescribing and monitoring of controlled substances.






Submit Conference Evaluation and Report CME
