

Core Objective 5

Maintain an up-to-date problem list of current and active diagnoses based on ICD-9-CM or SNOMED CT®. - **170.302(c)**

More than 80% of all unique patients seen by the EP have at least one entry or an indication that no problems are known for the patient recorded as structured data

An up-to-date problem list is maintained in eClinicalWorks in several locations. The initial problem list is created when the Assessment is entered. If the assessment is pre-configured to be automatically entered onto the problem list (certain chronic conditions, for example), the PL checkbox will automatically be checked upon selection of the condition. The provider can manually check the PL box as appropriate, adding the assessment to the problem list. The order of assessments can be changed as desired by the provider.
