Summary of care record for each transition of care/referrals - **170.304(i)**

The EP who transitions or refers their patient to another setting of care or provider of care provides a summary of care record for more than 50% of transitions of care and referrals

A Medical Summary can be generated from the Patient Hub and printed or faxed directly from the Summary. A Medical Summary can be attached to an outgoing referral and can be printed, faxed, or sent to the "Referring To" provider via eCW's P2P, a secure data exchange platform that can be used for communication between a provider that uses eCW and providers that use any EMR or no EMR at all.
