Definitions:

Program Categories:

"C" = Categorical positions; residents are expected to complete the training required for certification in this specialty;

"P" = Preliminary positions are for one or two years of training as prerequisite for advanced positions in specialty programs that require one or more years of broad clinical training.

"R" = Reserved for physicians with prior graduate training. These positions are PGY-2 positions starting in the year of the Match and are not available to U.S. senior medical students;

"A" = Advanced positions (beginning in 2012) are positions that begin AFTER completion of one or more years of preliminary training. Applicants can apply for preliminary positions (to start in 2011) and advanced positions (to start thereafter in 2012). All "A" positions are PGY-2 slots.
